### THE AVA

This is where Willamette Valley Pinot Noir all began. The first vines were planted in 1965 and Oregon has never looked back. Known for its volcanic soils, the Red Hills of Dundee produce wines bursting with red cherries, raspberries and a telltale spicy minerality gifted by the soil from the most densely planted area in the state.

### THE WINE

Generous nose of dark roasted coffee, mocha and violet. The mouthfeel is rich and smooth with smoky cinnamon and crunchy cherries framed by white pepper notes. The finish is polished with chocolate tannins.

### THE WINERY

At Domaine Divio, Bruno Corneaux applies his traditional Burgundian crafting skills to Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Achieved through minimal intervention and sustainability in respect of the land, the wines emphasize the elegance and complexity of our Willamette Valley grapes.
